



# 2008 Louisiana Family Physician of the Year

## CRITERIA & SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

### **Nominees must meet the following criteria:**

1. Be an "Active" member, in good standing, of the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians
2. Be active in his/her field and conform to the pledges made to the Academy
3. Be an active participant in his/her parish medical society and support all progress in the medical profession
4. Have made some outstanding contribution in his/her community in the social, religious or medical fields;
5. Have high morals
6. Have worthy ideals and practice them
7. Be a leader in civic development
8. Favor good schools in the community and have an interest in his/her community affairs

### **Nomination Documentation and Support includes:**

1. A completed nomination form. The form can be obtained from the LAFP website – [www.lafp.org](http://www.lafp.org). (Note: You must complete the "Reason for Nomination" section of the form explaining why you feel your nominee is special to our state and to the specialty of family medicine.)
2. One letter from a colleague and two letters from patients should be attached to the nomination form. (Additional letters of endorsement and support materials are recommended.)
3. Current CV of the nominee and an outline of the physician's activities and involvement in the community and the medical field. (Other outstanding contributions to civic or professional organizations should be included.)

### **Deadline**

Nominations and supporting documents must be received (via mail, fax, or email) at the LAFP office on or before March 1, 2008.
