The purpose of this award is to provide funding to the 2009 National Conference of Family Medicine Residents and Medical Students for a family medicine resident or medical student actively involved in a community service or advocacy project. Care for the homeless, disease management, fitness advocacy, health literacy, immunization, obesity prevention, and patient education are among the potential focus areas.

Eligibility:

A member of the American Academy of Family Physicians.
In good standing at your program/school.
Must not be receiving other funding to attend.
Must not be a past recipient of this award.

Rules and Regulations:

Application and supporting documents must be received via fax, e-mail or postmarked no later than May 1. Winners will be notified on May 29. You may only apply for one NC scholarship award annually. Scholarships will be awarded onsite. If you are unable to attend the conference, your scholarship will be forfeited.

REQUIRED WITH APPLICATION:

- Letter of support from one of the following:
 - A faculty member of your program or school **or**
 - An active member of the AAFP
- Essay addressing these six items (not to exceed three pages):
 - Brief explanation of project (purpose and goals)
 - Applicant's role in project
 - Methods utilized
 - Resources used (personnel, written materials, funding, etc.)
 - Organizational support utilized and/or received
 - Evaluation of project
