Opposition to Participation in the Prior Authorization Process

WHEREAS, Family Medicine physicians should seek to avoid barriers that impose unnecessary 1 2 burdens on physicians; and 3 4 WHEREAS, health insurance companies (HIC) and pharmacy benefit managers (PMS) have created an artificial obstruction in the form of the prior authorization process; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, HICs and PBMs have sufficient resources to adjudicate payment for medically necessary and appropriate services without burdening a physician or their staff with 8 9 bureaucratic non-medical tasks; and 10 11 WHEREAS, neither physicians nor their staff have such a fiduciary responsibility towards the HICs and PBMs; therefore be it 12 13 14 **RESOLVED**, that the Louisiana Academy of Family Physicians opposes any imposition of the prior authorization process which transfers that duty from the payor to the family medicine physician. 15
