31	Directors fiduciary responsibility for setting annual dues for other member classifications.						
32	Minimal dues increases have occurred one time in five years with the annual dues for active members being \$320 per year.

62 **AAFP History**

In 1994, the bylaws were amended to increase the active member dues cap to \$350. The cap was not increased for 14 years, until 2008, when it was increased to \$450. Thus, the rarity of seeking an increase in the cap is demonstrative of the board's caution in increasing dues, together with the long-standing trust by the COD in the board's management of active member dues decisions.
